

Airbag Bracket Instructions 63-87 Chev C10 Front

- 1. Raise and support car at a safe, comfortable working height. Let the front suspension hang freely.
- Remove coil springs, shock absorbers, and bump stops. Refer to factory service manual for proper disassembly procedure.



- 3. Hold the upper plate to the crossmember as shown in the picture to the left and clamp to frame. Using the plate as a template, drill 4 mounting holes in crossmember.
- 4. Insert air fitting into air spring using thread sealant. Remove the upper plate from the crossmember, and bolt onto air spring using 3/8" bolts.
- 5. Bolt lower cup bracket onto air spring using 3/8" bolt.
- 6. Route air line through frame, connect to air spring, and bolt upper bracket onto crossmember. The lower mount will just sit in the spring pocket on the control arm.
- 7. Reassemble front suspension, and cycle using a jack to check for clearance all around air spring.

NOTE: Some models will have a bump stop on the lower arm with a steel mount- this may need to be removed to allow clearance for the air bag. Cut the mount off of the arm and grind flush to prevent airbag damage.
